'Well dear a man goes through three phases.


In his 20's his willy is like an oak tree mighty and hard.

"What a coincidence!" says the farmer. As they clinked glasses the man asked, "What are you celebrating?" "


My husband and I have been trying to have a child and today my gynaecologist told me that I am pregnant!"

Chapter Nine: Four Things You Probably Never Knew Your Mobile Phone Could Do

This is the kind of information people won't mind receiving - please pass it on:

FOUR THINGS YOU PROBABLY NEVER KNEW YOUR MOBILE PHONE COULD DO:

There are a few things that can be done in times of grave emergencies. Your mobile phone can actually be a life saver or an emergency tool for survival. Check out the things that you can do with it:

FIRST Emergency

The Emergency Number worldwide for Mobile is 112. If you find yourself out of the coverage area of your mobile network and there is an emergency dial 112 and the mobile will search any existing network to establish the emergency number for you and interestingly this number 112 can be dialled even if the keypad is locked.

SECOND

Have you locked your keys in the car?

Does your car have remote keyless entry? This may come in handy someday. Good reason to own a cell phone:

If you lock your keys in the car and the spare keys are at home call someone at home on their mobile phone from your cell phone.

Hold your cell phone about a foot from your car door and

have the person at your home press the unlock button holding it near the mobile phone on their end. Your car will unlock. Saves someone from having to drive your keys to you. Distance is no object. You could be hundreds of miles away and if you can reach someone who has the other 'remote' for your car you can unlock the doors (or the trunk).

Editor's Note: It works fine! We tried it out and it unlocked our car over a mobile phone!'

THIRD

Hidden Battery Power

Imagine your mobile battery is very low. To activate press the keys *3370# Your mobile will restart with this reserve and the instrument will show a 50% increase in battery. This reserve will get charged when you charge your mobile next time.

FOURTH

How to disable a STOLEN mobile phone?

To check your Mobile phone's serial number key in the following digits on your phone: * # 0 6 #

A 15 digit code will appear on the screen. This number is unique to your handset. Write it down and keep it somewhere safe. When your phone gets stolen you can phone your service provider and give them this code. They will then be able to block your handset so even if the thief changes the SIM card your phone will be totally useless.

You probably won't get your phone back but at least you know that whoever stole it can't use/sell it either. If everybody does this there would be no point in people stealing mobile phones.

Also -ATM PIN Number Reversal - Good to Know

If you should ever be forced by a robber to withdraw money from an ATM machine you can notify the police by entering your PIN # in

reverse. For example: if your pin number is 1234 then you would put in 4321. The ATM system recognizes that your PIN number is backwards from the ATM card you placed in the machine. The machine will still give you the money you requested but unknown to the robber, the police will be immediately dispatched to the location.

ALL EUROPEAN LIFE DIED IN AUSCHWITZ

I walked down the street in Barcelona and suddenly discovered a terrible truth - Europe died in Auschwitz We killed six million Jews and replaced them with 20 million Muslims. Chapter Sixteen: Honey And Cinnamon

Facts on Honey and Cinnamon: It is found that a mixture of honey and cinnamon cures most diseases. Honey is produced in most of the countries of the world. Scientists of today also accept honey as a 'Ram Ban' (very effective) medicine for all kinds of diseases.

BAD BREATH:


People of South America first thing in the morning gargle with one teaspoon of honey and cinnamon powder mixed in hot water so their breath stays fresh throughout the day.

Early Warning Heart Attack

The attached message is important. Remember in NZ though we dial 111 in an emergency (not 911).

People present a heart attack in different ways - the enclosed tells some of them so be aware.

Early in May this year I did not know that I had had a heart attack until two days later. Luckily it had been a mild attack with minor damage to the heart. I had been having severe pain on and off in both arms for a few weeks previously. Around the time of the attack I had pain in my neck & jaw between my shoulders and left side under the arm. I Just thought I must have been overdoing it at the gym. The next two days I felt nauseous, dizzy and had diarrhoea then vomiting. The doctor did an ECG on me which prompted a blood test and then I was sent to hospital.

I was lucky and have recovered well (thanks to my lifestyle according to my doctor.) My **blood pressure** & cholesterol were normal. I work out at the gym - eat a healthy diet including quality supplements and look after myself.

You just never know.

The professionals told me that plaque in the arteries can happen in childhood. If any plaque breaks off (which can happen years later) blood clots are formed and cause a blockage.

This was what happened to me. I had 3 blood clots so they **pumped blood thinners** into me & performed a simple procedure called an **angioplasty** which involved inserting a tube through my wrist and ballooning the artery **to insert a stent** which widened the blocked artery. They were also able to check and assured me that the two main arteries were in good order. I was awake through the whole procedure and did not feel a thing.

Read the enclosed message and remember "**Time is of** the essence if you have any strange symptoms even if in doubt don't wait".

Dial 111. It is better to be safe than sorry.

I hope this helps you and your family and friends.

Chapter Twenty-Five: There Is An Alternative Way.

Interesting information....

AFTER YEARS OF TELLING PEOPLE CHEMOTHERAPY IS THE ONLY WAY TO TRY ('TRY BEING THE KEY WORD) TO ELIMINATE CANCER JOHNS HOPKINS IS FINALLY STARTING TO TELL YOU THERE IS AN ALTERNATIVE WAY.

Cancer Update from Johns Hopkins:

- 1. Every person has cancer cells in the body. These cancer cells do not show up in the standard tests until they have multiplied to a few billion. When doctors tell cancer patients that there are no more cancer cells in their bodies after treatment it just means the tests are unable to detect the cancer cells because they have not reached the detectable size.!
- 2. Cancer cells occur between 6 to more than 10 times in a person's lifetime.
- 3. When the person's immune system is strong the cancer cells will be destroyed and prevented from multiplying and forming tumours.
- 4. When a person has cancer it indicates the person has multiple nutritional deficiencies. These could be due to genetic environmental food and lifestyle factors.

- 5. To overcome the multiple nutritional deficiencies changing diet and including supplements will strengthen the immune system.
- 6. Chemotherapy involves poisoning the rapidly-growing cancer cells and also destroys rapidly-growing healthy cells in the bone marrow, gastrointestinal tract etc and can cause organ damage like liver, kidneys, heart. lungs etc.
- 7. Radiation while destroying cancer cells also burns scars and damages healthy cells, tissues and organs.
- 8. Initial treatment with chemotherapy and radiation will often reduce tumour size. However prolonged use of chemotherapy and radiation do not result in more tumour destruction.
- 9. When the body has too much toxic burden from chemotherapy and radiation the immune system is either compromised or destroyed; hence the person can succumb to various kinds of infections and complications.
- 10. Chemotherapy and radiation can cause cancer cells to mutate and become resistant and difficult to destroy.

 Surgery can also cause cancer cells to spread to other sites.!
- 11. An effective way to battle cancer is to starve the cancer

cells by not feeding it with the foods it needs to multiply.

CANCER CELLS FEED ON:

- a. Sugar is a cancer-feeder. By cutting off sugar it cuts off one important food supply to the cancer cells. Sugar substitutes like NutraSweet, Equal, Spoonful etc. are made with Aspartame which is extremely harmful. A better natural substitute would be Manuka honey or molasses but only in very small amounts. Table salt has a chemical added to make it white in colour. Better alternative is Bragg's Aminos or sea salt.
- b. **Milk** causes the body to produce mucus especially in the gastro-intestinal tract. Cancer feeds on mucus. By cutting off milk and substituting with almonds or macadamias blended with water to make a delicious milk cancer cells are being starved.
- c. Cancer cells thrive in an **acid environment**. A meatbased diet is acidic and it is best to eat fish and a little chicken rather than beef or pork. Meat also contains livestock antibiotics growth hormones and parasites which are all harmful especially to people with cancer.
- d. A diet made of 80% fresh vegetables and juice whole grains seeds nuts and a little fruits help put the body into an alkaline environment. About 20% can be from cooked

food including beans. Fresh vegetable juices provide live enzymes that are easily absorbed and reach down to cellular levels within 15 minutes to nourish and enhance growth of healthy cells. To obtain live enzymes for building healthy cells try and drink fresh vegetable juice (most vegetables including bean sprouts) and eat some raw vegetables 2 or 3 times a day. Enzymes are destroyed at temperatures of 104 degrees F (40 degrees C).

- e . **Avoid coffee, tea and chocolate** which have high caffeine. Green tea is a better alternative and has cancer fighting properties. Water best to drink purified water or filtered to avoid known toxins and heavy metals in tap water. **Distilled water is acidic** avoid it.
- 12. Meat protein is difficult to digest and requires a lot of digestive enzymes. **Undigested meat** remaining in the intestines become putrified and leads to more toxic buildup.
- 13. Cancer cell walls have a tough protein covering. By refraining from or eating less meat it frees more enzymes to attack the protein walls of cancer cells and allows the body's killer cells to destroy the cancer cells.
- 14. Some supplements build up the immune system (IP6 Flor-ssence Essiac anti-oxidants vitamins minerals EFAs etc.) to enable the body's own killer cells to destroy cancer

cells. Other supplements like vitamin E are known to cause apoptosis or programmed cell death, the body's normal method of disposing of damaged unwanted or unneeded cells.

15. Cancer is a disease of the mind, body and spirit. A proactive and positive spirit will help the cancer warrior be a survivor. Anger, unforgiveness and bitterness put the body into a stressful and acidic environment. Learn to have a loving and forgiving spirit. Learn to relax and enjoy life.

16. Cancer cells cannot thrive in an oxygenated environment. Exercising daily and deep breathing help to get more oxygen down to the cellular level. Oxygen therapy is another means employed to destroy cancer cells.

Manager at Castle Hospital was on a TV program to
explain this health hazard. He talked about dioxins and
how bad they are for us. He said that we should not be
heating our food in the microwave using plastic
containers This especially applies to foods that contain fat.
He said that the combination of fat, high heat and plastics
releases dioxin into the food and ultimately into the cells of
the body. Instead he recommends using glass such as
Corning Ware Pyrex or ceramic containers for heating
food. You get the same results only without the dioxin.


So TV dinners, instant ramen and soups etc. should be removed from the container and heated in something else. Paper isn't bad but you don't know what is in the paper. It's just safer to use tempered glass Corning Ware etc. He reminded us that a while ago some of the fast food restaurants moved away from the foam containers to paper. The dioxin problem is one of the reasons.

Also he pointed out that plastic wrap such as Saran is just as dangerous when placed over foods to be cooked in the microwave. As the food is nuked the high heat causes poisonous toxins to actually melt out of the plastic wrap and drip into the food. Cover food with a paper towel instead.
